

Kavin T. Grant is a native of Jacksonville Florida. He is an Assistant Professor of Dance at Alabama State University as well as an adjunct faculty member at Troy University in Troy, Alabama. He received his MFA in Dance with a concentration in Choreography and Performance from Temple University in Philadelphia, PA. He is the Founder and CEO of Kavin Grant Productions and Entertainment as well as the Artistic/Creative Director and Founder of The Dance Company Experience in Montgomery, Alabama.

Mr. Grant trained with Kariamu and Company:Traditions, Cedar Lake Contemporary Ballet, Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater, Florida Community College at Jacksonville and Jacksonville University where he earned his BFA in Dance with departmental honors and a minor in Sociology. In addition, he was chosen as one of three choreographers for the 2015 National Choreography Intensive with Ronald K. Brown of Evidence, A Dance Company. Mr. Grant specializes in classical and contemporary ballet, contemporary modern, hip-hop, jazz and African (Umfundalai).

His works have been accepted and presented at the International Association of Blacks in Dance, the New York Jazz Choreography Project, the National American College Dance Association and the Alabama Dance Festival. Also, he was invited to present his work at the I Dance Orlando Festival, Ballet Inc: The Series Volume I, and MachineHDance Summer Festival.
